1. (a) Briefly discuss the conflict between love and duty in *Abhijnanasakuntalam*.

OR

- (b) Analyze the character of Dushyanta as depicted by Kalidasa in the play *Abhijnanasakuntalam*.

2. (a) Comment on Sudraka's depiction of contemporary society in his play *Mrichchhakatikam*.

OR

- (b) Consider Charudatta as the hero of Sudraka's play *Mrichchhakatikam*.

3. (a) Critically comment on the significance of the Sabha Parva in *Mahabharata* with reference to the prescribed syllabus.

OR

- (b) Critically analyze the character of Yudhishtira as presented in the dicing episode in 'The Book of the Assembly Hall'.

4. (a) Analyse the role of the narrator in *Kadambari*.

OR

- (b) Comment on Bana's depiction of the king's court in *Kadambari*.

5. Write a short note on any *one* of the following in about 200 words: 5×1 = 5

- (a) Briefly comment on the role of Krishna in the dicing episode in ‘The Book of the Assembly Hall’ of *Mahabharata*.
- (b) Comment on the role of Maitreya in *Mrichchhakatikam*.
- (c) What is the function of the ring in Kalidasa’s play *Abhijnanasakuntalam*?
- (d) Describe the Chandala woman who comes to the king’s court in Bana’s *Kadambari*.
